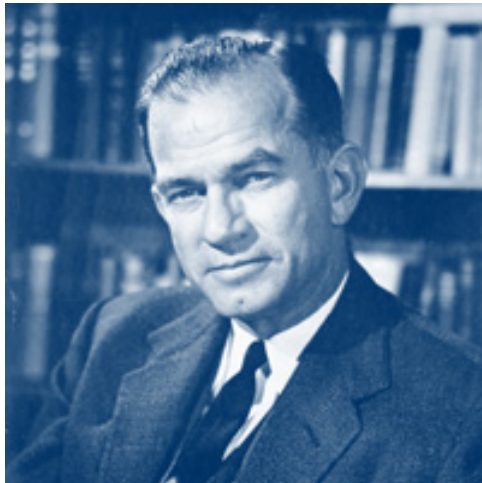

“International education exchange is the most significant current project designed to continue the process of humanizing mankind to the point, we would hope, that nations can learn to live in peace.”

Fulbright Scholar Program

- **Established in 1946**
- **Sends U.S. academics and professionals overseas and brings scholars and professionals from abroad to the U.S.**
- **Sponsored by U.S. Department of State’s Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs**
- **Administered by the Institute of International Education’s Council for International Exchange of Scholars (CIES)**

Distinguished Chairs Program

- **The Distinguished Chairs Program is designed for eminent scholars with substantial experience and publications in their respective fields.**
- **It is important for applicants to review award descriptions carefully in order to identify expectations for particular awards.**
- **Distinguished Chairs awards are viewed as among the most prestigious appointments in the Fulbright Scholars Program**

Distinguished Chairs Program

- **Thirty awards are offered in 14 countries across Europe. Chairs are also offered in Australia, Brazil, Canada and India.**
- **Awards for teaching, research or a combination of both are offered.**
- **Grants last between 3-10 months.**
- **Originally geared towards teaching in American Studies, Chairs are offered in such disciplines as entrepreneurship, information technology, energy, international law, and art.**



The Distinguished Chairs Categories

- **You may teach in Austria, Brazil, Canada, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, India, Italy, Poland, Russia, Sweden, and United Kingdom. Ten teaching-only opportunities are available.**
- **Research opportunities in Australia, Austria, Brazil, Canada Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Italy, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Sweden, and United Kingdom. Thirteen research/teaching and three research-only awards are available.**

Why a Fulbright Distinguished Chair Award?

- **Confirm your outstanding expertise: Gain added recognition from colleagues for your extensive scholarship.**
- **Participate in important global discussion: Inform colleagues and political leaders about the United States and the effects of your work within your own discipline.**
- **Potentially attract new funding: Use innovative scholarship to create opportunities to develop cross-institutional programs that can attract new grant funding.**
- **Promote transnational dialogue: Advance and promote dialogue on critical issues in higher education.**
- **Develop new networks: Collaborate with your hosts to develop new networks to expand your home institution's opportunities for faculty and students.**

Eligibility Requirements

- **U.S. citizenship**
- **A Ph.D. or equivalent professional/terminal degree in your field**
- **For professionals and artists outside academia: Recognized professional standing and substantial accomplishments**
- **Teaching experience as required by award**
- **Limits apply to prior Fulbright Scholar grantees**

Language

- **All Teaching awards are in English.**
- **Knowledge of the host country's language is desirable but not required. Translation assistance is available in Poland, and teaching can be done in English or Polish.**
- **For Research awards, language ability must be commensurate with nature of project**

Frequently Asked Questions...

- **What is the deadline?**

August 2

- **What must I include in my application?**

Each submission should include the following core items:

Application form with all items completed and signed

Project Statement (up to five pages)

**Tailored curriculum vitae or resume, including a list of selected publications
(up to eight pages)**

**Letter of invitation or other relevant correspondence from abroad, if
applicable.**

Additional documentation depending on the award

- **Do you have to be a department or endowed chair?**

No. The award specifies that you have substantial body of work in your field.



Frequently Asked Questions...

- **Do applications for teaching and research awards require the same additional documentation**
 - **Research awards must include:**
 - **A select bibliography (up to three pages) and three reference letters**
 - **Teaching or teaching/research awards must include:**
 - **Course syllabi**
 - **Two reference letters**
 - **One teaching report**
- **How do I apply?**
