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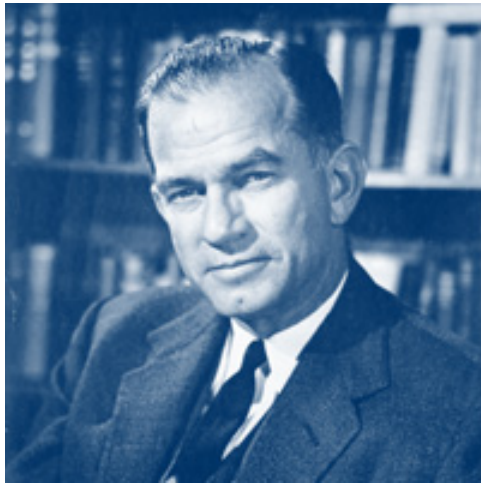

**“International education exchange is the most significant current project designed to continue the process of humanizing mankind to the point, we would hope, that nations can learn to live in peace.”**

## Fulbright Scholar Program

- **Established in 1946**
- **Sends U.S. academics and professionals overseas and brings scholars and professionals from abroad to the U.S.**
- **Sponsored by U.S. Department of State’s Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs**
- **Administered by the Institute of International Education’s Council for International Exchange of Scholars (CIES)**

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## Eligibility Requirements

- **U.S. citizenship**
- **A Ph.D. or equivalent professional/terminal degree in your field**
- **For professionals and artists outside academia, professional standing and accomplishments**
- **Teaching experience if required by award**
- **Limits apply to prior Fulbright Scholar grantees**

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## What is the Core Fulbright Program?

- **The original core of the Fulbright program**
- **Over 1100 awards each year for U.S. applicants; approximately 75 awards to India**
- **Grants for teaching or conducting research**
- **Lengths vary from 2 to 12 months; for India, 4 to 9 months**
- **Seminars 2 to 3 weeks**

- **4 to 6 Months**
- **Open to professionals and early career faculty**

### **Distinguished Chair**

- **Higher Education or Study of the U.S.**
- **4 Months**

### **Medical Sciences, Communications, Information Technology**

- **4 Months**
- **Open to professionals and early career faculty**

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## Other South Asia Countries

- **Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka**
- **“All Discipline” structure – interest in a variety of disciplines**
- **Some priority fields - business administration, public administration, TEFL, law, health sciences, environmental studies, journalism, study of the U.S.**
- **Availability of research and teaching awards varies by country**
- **Teaching in English**
- **South & Central Asia Regional Research Program – two or more countries, including Central Asia**

**Letter of Invitation**

Writing and Journalism**

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## **Additional Opportunities in India**

- **Fulbright Specialists Program**
- **Seminars for International Education Administrators**

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## **Fulbright Specialists Program**

- **Two- to six-week consulting and/or teaching opportunities**
- **Online application to Fulbright Specialist roster with rolling deadline**
- **Institutions overseas develop projects and request specialists from the roster**
- **Program does not support research**
- **Twenty eligible academic and professional disciplines**
- **Minimum of two years between grants**
- **Limits apply to prior Fulbright Scholar grantees**

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# International Education Administrators Seminars

- **The following countries are involved with the IEA program:**

**Germany, India, Japan and Korea**

- **The International Education Administrators (IEA) seminars program helps international education professionals and senior higher education officials from the United States create empowering connections with the societal, cultural and higher education systems of other countries.**
- **Grantees have the opportunity to learn about the host country's education system from the inside out as well as establish networks of U.S. and international colleagues. Grantees return with enhanced ability to serve and encourage international students and prospective study-abroad students**

### **International Education Administrators Seminar: 2-3 weeks.**

- **May 28th , 2010. Application Deadline. Seminar in late October 2010.**
- **Attend meetings with representatives of Indian universities, private-sector agencies and organizations and selected government agencies.**
- **Visit university international offices. Respond to questions about U.S. higher education. U.S. administrators will have the opportunity to familiarize themselves with program designs, organizational structures, quality assurance procedures and credit and degree expectations in Indian higher education.**
