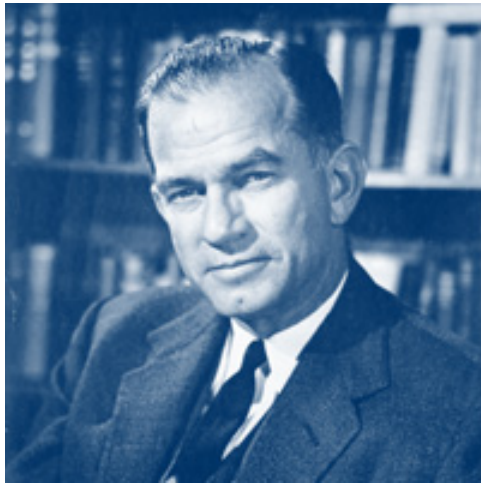

“International education exchange is the most significant current project designed to continue the process of humanizing mankind to the point, we would hope, that nations can learn to live in peace.”

Fulbright Scholar Program

- **Established in 1946**
- **Sends U.S. academics and professionals overseas and brings scholars and professionals from abroad to the U.S.**
- **Sponsored by U.S. Department of State’s Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs**
- **Administered by the Institute of International Education’s Council for International Exchange of Scholars (CIES)**

What is the Core Fulbright Program?

- **The original core of the Fulbright program**
- **Over 800 awards each year for U.S. applicants**
- **Grants for teaching, conducting research, or both**
- **Lengths vary from 2 to 12 months**
- **Seminars 2 to 3 weeks**

Eligibility Requirements

- **U.S. citizenship**
- **A Ph.D. or equivalent professional/terminal degree in your field**
- **For professionals and artists outside academia, recognized professional standing and substantial accomplishments**
- **Teaching experience as required by award**
- **Limits apply to prior Fulbright Scholar grantees**

Fulbright Scholar Awards in China Summary

- **Approximately 32 awards: research, teaching or teaching/research**
- **Distinguished Lectureships: Economics, Law and Study of the United States**
- **Study of the United States**
 - 12 teaching awards**
 - open to early career scholars**
- **Medium of instruction is English**
- **Teaching or teaching/research awards in specific fields**
 - economics**
 - journalism**
 - law**
 - library science**
 - public administration**

Summary - Continued

- **Approximately 12 research awards**
 - Social Sciences and Humanities**
 - China specialists**
 - Non-specialists**
- **Salary supplement for teaching and teaching/research awards**
- **No “All Disciplines” awards**
- **Award duration – 3 to 10 months**
- **No awards in sciences, engineering, mathematics, medical sciences**

China - Types of Awards

Distinguished Lecturer Awards

Economics - Law – Study of the United States

- **Full professors, distinguished record of scholarship and publication**
- **Non-academic professionals in economics and law with teaching experience, record of scholarship and publication are eligible**
- **5 or 10 months, affiliation with major universities**
- **Salary supplement**

Study of the United States: 12 Teaching Awards

- **Open to all academic ranks, including early career scholars**
- **Teach in English**
- **Diverse specializations:**
 - American literature**
 - American history**
 - American studies**
 - Education**
 - Philosophy**
 - Political Science**
- **Ministry of Education determines host institution (applicants may indicate preference)**

Awards in Specific Disciplines: Teaching or Teaching/Research

- **Fields: Economics, Journalism, Law, Library & Information Science, Public Administration/Public Policy**
- **Applicant determines the activity: Teaching or Teaching/research**
- **Teaching in English; Mandarin useful for research**
- **Ministry of Education determines host institution (applicants may indicate preference)**

More on Teaching & Teaching/Research Awards

- **Applicants should not contact Chinese institutions**
- **Ministry of Education arranges affiliation**
- **Applicants may indicate institutional preference**
- **Teaching load is maximum of two graduate or undergraduate courses per semester, 8 class hours weekly**
- **Teaching/research awards are primarily for teaching; class load will not be reduced**
- **Affiliation with host institutions throughout China**
- **Affiliation other than in Beijing and Shanghai highly encouraged**
- **Host institutions generally provide on-campus housing**
- **Book allowance and language study allowance provided**
- **Salary supplement provided, calculated on base U.S. salary**

Research: China Studies

- **Approximately 9 awards – 3 to 10 months duration**
- **Most disciplines of humanities & social sciences, also film studies, public administration, public health, urban planning**
- **Ph.D. and facility in Mandarin required**
- **Open to Senior Scholars and to Early Career Scholars 3 years beyond Ph.D.**
- **Projects on modern or pre-modern China**
- **A portion of longer grants may be in Taiwan or Hong Kong**

Research: Social Sciences or Humanities

- **Opportunities for scholars who are not China or Asia specialists who want to establish expertise or carry out comparative work**
- **Mandarin required/not required according to need of project**
- **Assistant professors 3 years beyond Ph.D. may apply**
- **Non-academic professionals with record of research & publication are eligible**
- **Part of research period in Hong Kong or Taiwan, if necessary**
- **Applicants may arrange affiliation with host institution**
