## Invite a Fulbright Visiting Scholar to Your Campus

The Occasional Lecturer Fund (OLF) provides travel funds for Fulbright Visiting Scholars already in the United States to visit your campus.

### Through this program, you can invite a Fulbright Visiting Scholar to:

- Offer department or school-wide lectures to students and/or faculty.
- Lecture to classes where the scholar can make a contribution to a discipline.
- Meet with faculty to exchange ideas and engage in informal discussions with students.
- Engage the wider community around your campus.

### To participate, Fulbright Visiting Scholars must first be invited by a U.S. college or university.

There is particular interest in scholars who wish to visit institutions that serve predominantly minority student populations. U.S. administrators are encouraged to use this directory to identify a scholar of interest.

### How U.S. institutions use Occasional Lecturer Fund (OLF)

A **Romanian Fulbright Visiting Scholar at the University of Colorado—Denver, CO** visited Hostos Community College, NY where he spoke to faculty and students about Romania's higher education and culture and presented a slide show of Romanian cities and landscapes.

A **Nigerian Fulbright Scholar-in-Residence at LeMoyne-Owen College, TN** participated in a panel discussion on Islam and Africa at a conference sponsored by Norfolk State University, VA, in conjunction with the World Affairs Council of Greater Hampton Roads, VA. He also spoke on "Islam in Africa: Past and Present."

A **Brazilian Fulbright Scholar-in-Residence at Fairfield University, CT** was invited to visit two Hispanic-Serving institutions—the University of La Verne, CA and Universidad Metropolitana, PR. The guest lecturer spoke about the synergy among social inequalities, models of resource utilization and global climate change.
