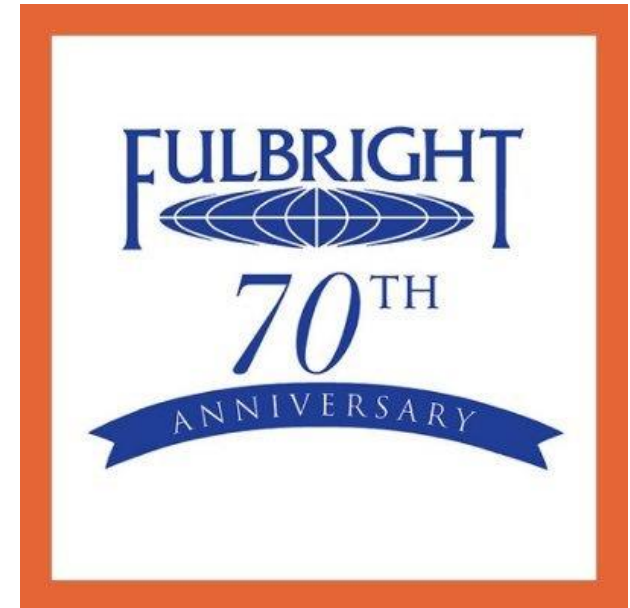

# Eligibility for IEA Seminars

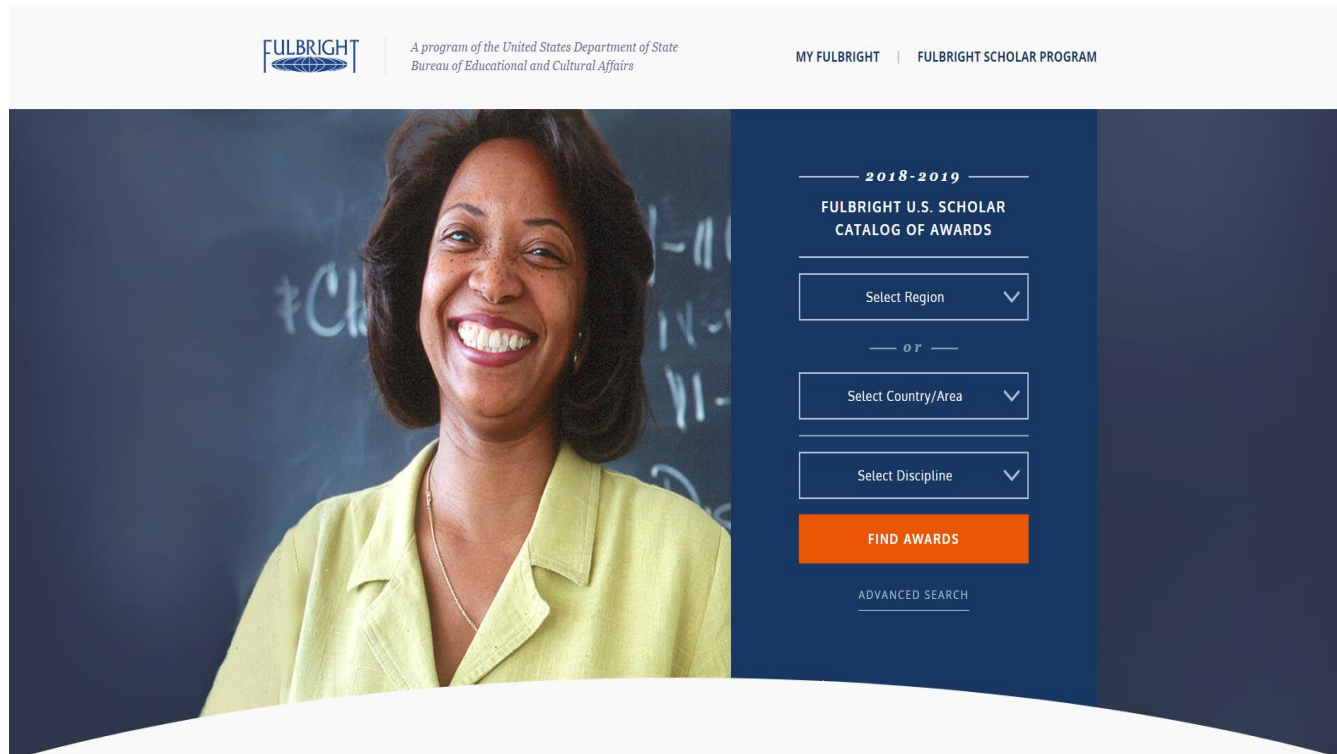
- U.S. citizenship
- Ph.D. or other terminal degree not required
- Appropriate professional experience and accomplishments
- Additional requirements vary by award
- New policies on previous Fulbright Scholar grants and waiting periods between grants

# Fulbright-Nehru IEA Program (India)

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## Grant Details

Application Deadline: August 1, 2017

Grant dates: Two weeks, March 2018

Locations: New Delhi and other major cities; visit universities and colleges, government agencies, research institutes, NGOs

## Professional Profile

International education administrators (for example, foreign student advisors, study abroad advisors and foreign student admissions) **or**

Senior-level university administrators (deans, vice presidents, provosts and presidents)

Minimum of five years of experience in the field

## Preferred Qualifications

Preference given to applicants without prior professional connects to India **and** whose home institutions do not have an established partnership or affiliation with Indian host institutions of higher learning

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# U.S.-Taiwan IEA Program

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## Grant Details

Application Deadline: August 1, 2017

Grant dates: Two weeks, March 2018

Locations: Universities and institutions throughout Taiwan

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## Professional Profile

Senior-level university administrators (directors, deans, vice presidents, provosts, and presidents) whose current role includes a **substantial** responsibility for enhancing the international dimension of their campus **or**

Study abroad advisors with at least three years of experience

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## Additional Qualifications

Affiliated with a two- or four-year college or university or a non-profit international education exchange organization; **and**

Without significant professional visits to Taiwan in the last two years; **and**

Institutional interest in increasing the number of Americans studying in Taiwan

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# Application Components

- Application Form
- Project Statement
- Curriculum Vitae or Resume
- Institutional Statement
- Letters of Reference

Deadline (India, Taiwan): August 1, 2017



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# Submitting a Competitive Application

- Fulbright goal: promote mutual understanding
- Why you are interested in this seminar and why in this country
  - How your responsibilities relate to this grant
  - Does your university have any affiliation with the host country or does it plan to develop its affiliation
- Cultural diplomacy; demonstrated flexibility, adaptability
- Outcomes, impact, and multiplier effect
  - for your professional development, home campus, students, field at large; for your host institution
  - future collaborations; linkages: personal, professional, institutional; plans for sustaining relationships
  - internationalizing campus and curriculum

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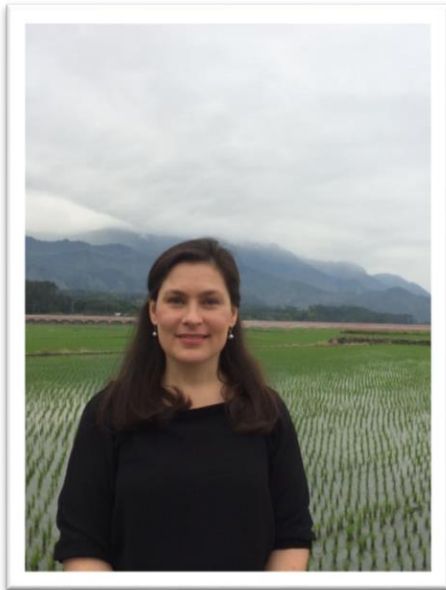
